About GURU POURNIMA UTSAV

The full moon day in the Hindu month of Ashad (July-August) is observed as the auspicious day of Guru Pournima, a day sacred to the memory of the great sage Vyasa. All Hindus are indebted to this ancient saint who edited the four Vedas, wrote the 18 Puranas, the Mahabharata and the Srimad Bhagavata. Vyasa even taught Dattatreya, who is regarded as the Guru of Gurus. On this day, all devotees worship their respective Guru in honor of their divine personage by performing 'Puja' of their respective spiritual preceptor or 'Gurudevs'.

Significance of GURU POURNIMA in Sangh

From Sangh's perspective, this day is of utmost importance. As in Sangh, we have Param Pavitar Bhagva Dhvaj as Guru. On this day all Swayamsevaks and Swayamsevikas worship Bhagva Dhvaj.
